

**Board Policy**  
**Legal Status of the School Board**

**Descriptor: B1**

The Board of Directors is the policy-making body of the Main Street School of Performing Arts and has complete fiscal powers for operating schools. These powers include setting policy, educational leadership and professional growth and development, judicial/legal, instructional program, board-principal performance, planning and work, facilities, board-principal relations and board-community relations, finance, personnel, and ensuring that equipment and facilities are available for learning.

The Board will review the mission of the Main Street School of Performing Arts every five years through a strategic planning process that involves parents, staff, students and community representatives. The Board will also conduct a review of its policies every year to ensure that they continue to support the mission of the Main Street School of Performing Arts.
