**Mathematics:**

- Students may use calculators in most math classes. A scientific calculator, such as a TI-30XS, will suffice in Intro to Mathematics, and the Integrated Algebra / Geometry sequences. Advanced Algebra and further courses will teach students to use the additional tools available in a Texas Instruments graphing calculator (TI-84) . Cell phone apps will NOT be allowed on tests.
- Set of colored pencils and ¼ inch graphing paper
- A red or purple pen, for marking corrections on assignments
- For Integrated Geometry, students should have the 10-piece math construction set (avoid the \$2.50 protractor and compass set), including a ruler and protractor, available at Target, Office Depot, or through your instructor

- All dancers: Black tights, pink tights or black leggings, and ballet shoes
- Solid color leotard for female identifying dancers
- Fitted solid color T-shirt for male identifying dancers and dance belt (men's support undergarment)

**Modern, Jazz, and Tap**

- All dancers: Black leggings or solid color joggers, solid color leotard or fitted solid color shirt. For male identifying dancers: dance belt (men's support undergarment)
- Shoes: Modern (bare feet/ cotton socks); Jazz (jazz shoes/ cotton socks); Tap (tap shoes); Hip Hop (sneakers)
