- Knowledge in the areas of math/science preferred but not required.

Responsibilities:

- Case manage students in grades 9 -12
- Work collaboratively with fellow teachers to provide accommodations for students with special needs
- Implement the curriculum and/or develop curriculum individually, in small groups and in the regular education classroom for adolescent students having moderate to severe learning difficulties and/or emotional behavioral disabilities.
- Serve as case manager for students with IEPs demonstrating the ability to do data collection, assess student performance, conduct IEP meetings, and communicate effectively with parents and staff
- Additional duties as assigned by administrator meet deadlines and be responsible for organization of all due process and related procedures
